## **CELEBRATIONS PROPER TO THE OMI (2010)**

### **25<sup>th</sup> January :**

- Conversion of Saint Paul
- 194 Anniversary of the foundation of the Congregation.

### **17<sup>th</sup> February :**

- Ash Wednesday.
- The celebration of the 184<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the approval of our Congregation and Constitutions is anticipated to Tuesday **February 16<sup>th</sup>** :
  - Mass proper of Thanksgiving for our vocation.
  - All priests offer the Mass for the Congregation's intentions
  - Renewal of vows
  - Act of Consecration to Mary Immaculate

### **21<sup>st</sup> May:**

**Saint Eugene de Mazenod**, Bishop and Founder of our Congregation.

**Solemnity.** Mass proper;

**Colour:** white,

*Gloria and Credo*, Preface proper. Liturgy of Hours, according to the ritual for solemnities, is taken from the OMI Proper and from the Common of Pastors; *Te Deum*.

**At Midday Office:** proper antiphon and gradual psalms.

### **21- 29 May:**

Time of prayer and animation for **Oblate vocations**.

### **29<sup>th</sup> May:**

Blessed Joseph Gerard, priest. Memorial

### **12<sup>th</sup> June:**

Blessed Joseph Cebula, martyr. Memorial

### **3<sup>rd</sup> November (or other free day):**

Community Mass for our deceased.

### **8<sup>th</sup> December:**

**Immaculate Conception** of the Blessed Virgin Mary: Titular and principal Patron of the Congregation. Solemnity. Everything as in the Missal and the Liturgy of Hours. Act of consecration to Mary Immaculate.

## **IN OUR CHURCHES AND ORATORIES**

Anniversary of the Dedication (if the church or oratory is consecrated), either on the exact day of the anniversary, or on the day specified in the local church calendar for celebrating the anniversary of the dedication of all the churches within the territory; Solemnity. All from the Common of the Dedication. (1st Vespers, Gloria and Credo, Gradual psalms for the Midday Office), we also celebrate the solemnity of the church's (or main oratory's) titular saint, if it has been consecrated or solemnly blessed.
